

ARRIVAL, RIGGING, MEASUREMENT & INSPECTION, and CRANING IN

Upon arrival in Torquay follow the signs to the Harbour and proceed to Daddyhole Plain, TQ1 2EG (see also the attached map). Royal Torbay Yacht Club volunteers will be there to welcome you and direct you to your allocated trailer space from 10.00 am Wednesday 6th to Friday 8th until approximately 18.00 each day, and from 08.00 until 14.00 on Saturday 9th September. If you are delayed please advise us, if at all possible by email to <u>events@rtyc.org</u> or telephone +44 (0)7970353660. Initial unpacking and preparation for rigging may be carried out at Daddyhole Plain. Stepping of the mast to be carried on Haldon Pier.

At Daddyhole Plain trailers will be parked around the edge of the area which is locked overnight and throughout the event. Although the compound will be locked you may wish to bring a trailer security device with you. We are required to keep the central area clear; this may be marked "H" as it is a helicopter landing pad.

Measurement and equipment inspection will take place on Haldon Pier, sail checks and administration in the adjacent marquee, at the times specified in the Notice of Race.


Rigging, measurement, inspection and craning in will be a continuous process and you should book your arrival day/ time at Haldon Pier click <u>HERE</u>. Please do not arrive before your booked time.

When you arrive at Haldon Pier for your pre booked inspection and craning in slot you will be directed and shown where your trailer may be parked for rigging, prior to measurement, inspection and craning in. When measurement and inspection is complete, craning in will take place towards the end of Haldon Pier.

After craning your road trailer should be returned to your allocated space at Daddyhole Plain as quickly as possible to reduce congestion on Haldon Pier and in the inspection area.

A clearway must be maintained at all times along Haldon Pier for commercial and emergency vehicles. Once you have returned your trailer to Daddyhole Plain your car may be parked in the car park at the Harbour.

Crew weighing and event registration will take place on the ground floor of the Royal Torbay Yacht Club, Beacon Terrace just above the harbour and on the opposite side of the road from the top floor of the car park.
