There is no telephone number for them. I have been frustrated at every time and at every turn. In desperation I would ask the OA to complain, formally, to World Sailing.

I have always raced in Dragon events as a Grade 1 sailor. My occupation is Interior Designer. I have never received a penny for my sailing over my lifetime. If we were doing this in 2024, I would be Grade 1 as I shall then

be seventy years old, and then automatically classified
as Grade 1.


I am sure, by now, you will have gained an idea

I am awaiting a response from World Sailing to re-new my sailor number.


